The project aims to deliver a high-quality integrated public realm for the City that protects and enhances the area and co-ordinates key infrastructure improvements at one of our primary civic spaces within the city. Broadly, the project aims to:

- Improve the provision for active travel infrastructure (for both walking and cycling)
- Improve biodiversity with the provision of landscaping, mature trees etc.
- Incorporate a flood defence wall and seating.
- Provide new public lighting design, civil infrastructure and district heating.

This non-statutory public consultation and workshop event is aimed at gathering local knowledge at an early stage in the preliminary design process which will inform the development of the Project.

The event will be held on 10th November 2022 in the St. Andrews Resource Centre, 114 - 116 Pearse Street, Dublin 2 from 2.00pm to 6.00pm. As the project advances there will be further opportunities for the public to engage as part of the statutory public consultation process under Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, for Local Authority Works procedures.
